

Timeline of Islam

Material to Master: As Islam spread to new settings in Afro-Eurasia, believers adapted it to local cultural practices. The split between the Sunni and Shi'a traditions of Islam intensified, and Sufi practices became more widespread.

Directions: With a partner you are to create a timeline of the global history of Islam from 600 to 1750 that demonstrates an understanding of the Material to Master above.

- Each inch of your timeline must equal 20 years
- You must have a map showing growth at least every 100 years
- Your timeline should be color coded as follows
 - Black: Major events in the development of Islam
 - Green: Events in the spread of Islam
 - Red: evidence of Islam adapting to local customs
 - Blue: Events leading to the split in Islam and evidence of its intensification
 - Brown: Evidence of Sufi Practices becoming more widespread
